Home Equity Conversion - The City provides fund to a non-profit organization, Eden Council for Hope and Opportunity (ECHO), to provide reverse mortgage programs services to seniors. For more information, [contact ECHO](#).

ECHO Home Equity Conversion Counseling Program - provides education and counseling on reverse mortgages and home equity conversion instruments to very low- to moderate-income senior homeowners.

The Center for Independent Living (CIL) - provides housing search services and housing rights counseling to Oakland's physically and mentally disabled residents. The overall objective of this program is to prevent homelessness and institutionalization of disabled persons.
